BIGGLESWADE NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN

Our town's Local Plan is now at the first draft stage and our Town Council have commenced formal consultation (known as Regulation 14, in accordance with the Neighbourhood Planning Regulations 2012). The Public Consultation runs Monday 27th September 2021 to 8th November 2021, to give enough time for the Plan to be brought to the attention of people living, working and undertaking businesses or services in Biggleswade and the neighbouring areas. An explanatory leaflet is expected to be delivered to every home in Biggleswade and businesses will be alerted as well.

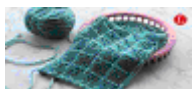

NEW MONDAY MORNING DROP IN AT THE WEATHERLEY CENTRE

Covid and the lock downs has resulted in some of the weekly coffee mornings that used to take place in Biggleswade, and some of the various support groups, closing down and may not reopen. Other groups have moved from weekly to monthly meetings, so there is less opportunity for us all to pick up the pieces of our normal lives before Covid, and come back out into the world and reform relationships or make new ones.

Biggleswade Community Group have access to a small fund that can initially help subsidise the cost of a morning drop in. We are trialling this for 6 months to see if this is the kind of social setting people would like to come to. No age restrictions at all and the Centre has disabled access and a large car park and is near to all the local bus routes.

The drop in will be open each Monday in the Purcell Room from 10.30 to 12 noon. There will be no membership – just walk in - but we will have to make a small charge of £1.50 to help with hall hire, plus 50p for an optional hot drink and biscuits.

This is not a support group but intended to be a welcoming, social one, in pleasant surroundings. However, with the networks Biggleswade Community Group have built up, we should be able to signpost attendees to someone who may help with any issues or concerns they may have.

BIGGLESWADE NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN (continued)



Over the past 4 years, on behalf of Biggleswade Town Council, members of the Biggleswade community have been preparing a Biggleswade Neighbourhood Plan covering the whole of the Parish area.

The Town Council has undertaken two consultations, in both 2019 and again in 2021, with the results being similar each time. Background evidence has also been gathered so that the draft Plan has a strong evidence base.

Following the consultation responses, and any amendments which may be made to the draft Plan, it is hoped that this will be submitted to Central Bedfordshire Council, for their approval, in the autumn of 2021. After that an independent inspector has to examine the Plan and then, if it is agreed, we will hold a local referendum in Biggleswade to approve the Plan, which is likely to take place in May 2022.

It is therefore important that we receive any comments from you during the consultation period. You can comment

LIMITED GREEN WASTE COLLECTION IN OCTOBER TIDY TIP BOOKINGS NO LONGER REQUIRED

Central Bedfordshire Council has announced that it will be undertaking a garden waste collection during a two week period in October between the 18th and 30th October to clear the backlog of waste in residents' garden waste bins before the winter period. However, **FOOD WASTE WILL NOT BE COLLECTED DURING THESE TWO DATES.** The Council's contractor, FCC, has been unable to collect household garden waste since late July due to the national shortage of LGV drivers and have been prioritising black bins, recycling and food waste from the 120,000 properties in the Central Bedfordshire area.

NOTE: Bookings are no longer required to visit the Biggleswade Household Waste Site and the permit system for non-commercial vans, large trailers and certain materials will be reinstated. Residents with sufficient space in their gardens are encouraged to home compost. A 220 litre compost bin, can be purchased at a subsidised cost through the Council.

BOOSTER COVID VACCINATIONS

According to the BLMK Clinical Commissioning Group website vaccinations are to be delivered at the now closed Registry Office at 142 London Road SG18 8EL and at Lloyds Pharmacy in the Market Square and only through the 119 phone line or National Database. Otherwise the nearest centre seems to be Chicksands in Shefford. You will only be able to book your booster **AFTER** you have been contacted by your GP.

There must be a minimum of 6 months between your 2nd vaccination and your booster jab. There are no walk-in facilities for boosters to ensure safety. Boosters will be offered to:

- those living in residential care homes for older adults
- all adults 50 years and over
- frontline health and social care workers
- all those aged 16 to 49 years with underlying health conditions that put them at higher risk of severe COVID-19 (as set out in the green book) and adult carers.
- adult household contacts of immunosuppressed individuals

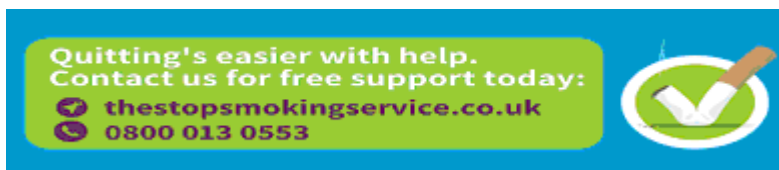

LOCAL WELFARE FUNDING PROVISION

With the top up for Universal Credit coming to an end, on the 30th September, the Government announced £500m of grants to help families struggling with the cost of living as other support schemes are withdrawn.

Local councils in England will distribute small grants to support millions of households, the government said. The new fund will run over the winter and replaces the Covid 19 local support grant programme, which was designed to support those most in need across England with the cost of food, energy, water bills and other daily needs.
