The controversial housing scheme for 416 dwellings on a 43-acre site north of Furzenhall Road is going ahead after being resubmitted. It includes access via a new connection from the roundabout at Potton Road Baden Powell Way. A smaller part of the site (with up to 74 dwellings), will be accessed via

Furzenhall Road to the south of the site.

Plans include green infrastructure accommodating landscaping, allotments, a community orchard and public open space. A buyer is being sought, likely to be a house builder or a consortium
